



ABOUT US

HealthFinders Collaborative (HFC) evolved from a handful of caring people at St. Dominic Church in Northfield who recognized the need to improve healthcare access in the community. HFC now consists of two community offices, located in Northfield and Faribault.

A dedicated group of staff and volunteer medical providers, nurses, interpreters, and receptionists provide basic care, while local hospitals and community and health system partners support HFC with in-kind outside lab and imaging services. HFC collaborates with Sterling Pharmacy for medical prescriptions and partners with other community organizations to meet the needs of the people we serve.

HealthFinders Collaborative's fundamental belief is in supporting people's inherent capacity to be well.

PROGRAMS & SERVICES

Ensuring healthcare access for everyone.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR CARE?

We attempt to help everyone who calls us for assistance, whether through our own services or a referral to another resource. Our primary care services are limited to:

- Patients without insurance*
- Patients with Medical Assistance or other public insurances
- A household income at or below 200% of the current federal poverty level

** Uninsured patients are charged on a sliding-fee scale (income-dependent). However, we do not turn anyone away if they are unable to pay.*

MEDICATION ASSISTANCE

HealthFinders offers prescription medication assistance to uninsured Rice County residents who cannot afford their medications. Co-pays may apply, however waivers are available, if needed.

COMMUNITY HEALTH WORKERS

Community Health Workers extend the reach of the clinic care team and help patients overcome barriers through culturally-responsive education and personalized home visits.

PRIMARY CARE SERVICES

Our facilities are staffed by medical/dental providers, nurses, receptionists, interpreters, and clinic coordinators.

MEDICAL CARE: Preventive, acute, and chronic primary care are offered at our locations in Faribault and Northfield.

DENTAL CARE: Exams, cleanings, fillings, extractions, and individualized oral healthcare are offered at our Faribault location.

MENTAL HEALTH: We offer clinical and preventive intervention services centered on working to both alleviate psychological distress and produce resiliency and ongoing wellness. Bilingual services are available.

PATIENT ADVOCACY

Advocates provide enrollment assistance for MNsure in addition to connecting patients to community resources and social service programs in Rice County.

TEEN SERVICES

MESA offers convenient clinical services to Latinx youth throughout Rice County school districts. This includes general primary care, mental health services, and youth programming.

DIABETES PROGRAM

Participants receive testing supplies, medication, lab work, and regular clinic visits. Additionally, the diabetes program includes one-on-one education and participation in support groups and self-management classes.

PURA VIDA PROGRAM

The Pura Vida Program offers nutrition, exercise, and education classes at a variety of locations. On-site childcare is provided.

COMMUNITY SERVICES

Many of our services and programs are delivered in various community sites. Community Health Workers are also available to visit patients in their homes.

OPIATE ADDICTION THERAPY

We offer Medication Assisted Treatment (MAT) using Suboxone/Buprenorphine at the HFC-MAT Clinic (1415 Town Square Lane, Faribault). Call 507.323.8100 to schedule an appointment.
